On July 30, 2008, the Federal Election Commission notified Vernon Jones for Georgia ("Committee") of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On April 21, 2009, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by the Committee that there is no reason to believe the Committee violated Federal Election Campaign Act or Commission regulations. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on April 21, 2009.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A Statement of Reasons further explaining the basis for the Commission's decision will follow.
